What is the meaning of Christ the King Sunday?

Each year on the Sunday before Advent begins, we in the church, celebrate the liturgical day known as Christ the King Sunday. This year we will mark that day on November 23.

What is it exactly? Christ the King Sunday celebrates Jesus spiritual kingship and dominion over all creation, instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 to counter growing secularism and remind believers of their ultimate allegiance to Christ rather than to earthly powers. The feast is celebrated on the last Sunday of the liturgical year before Advent, emphasizing that Christ's reign is both a present reality in the lives of believers and a future hope for the ultimate culmination of his kingdom.

NEW MEMBER CLASSES


