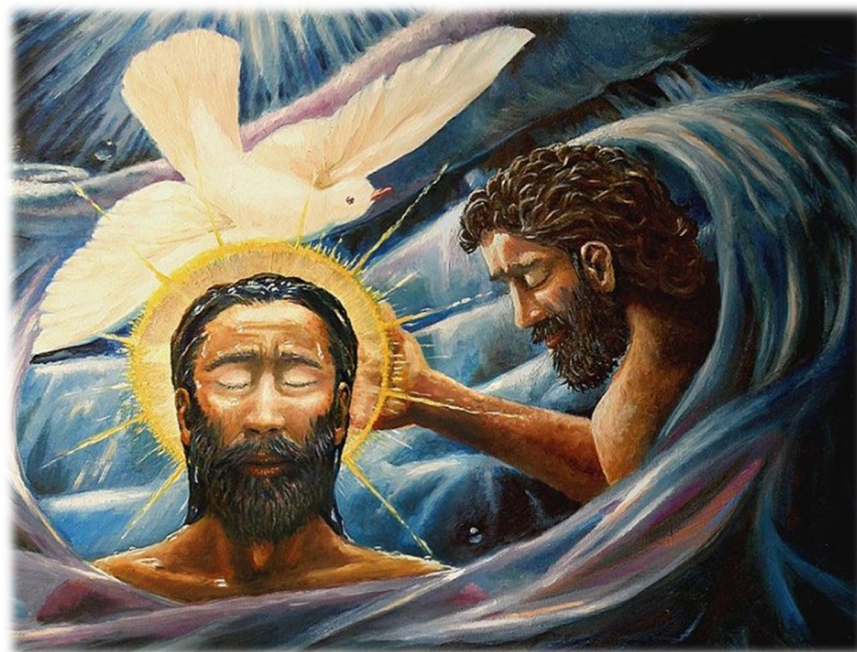

We Prepare Our Hearts and Minds:

Today's gospel sets before us two choices. We can either resist, forbid, and try to prevent what is coming to us, which is what John wants to do. Or we can permit it and "let it be," which is what Jesus tells John to do. "Let it be so now," Jesus says to John. "Then he consented." What if that's to be our way too? What if Jesus is saying to us, "Let it be so now?" What if we too are being asked to consent? The consent to which Jesus calls us isn't simply about giving up, acquiescing, approving, or agreeing. It's about a way of life. It's about Jesus' way of life. It doesn't mean we have to like or want what is happening. It does, however, mean that we face it and deal with it.
