Chancel vases \$30.00 each

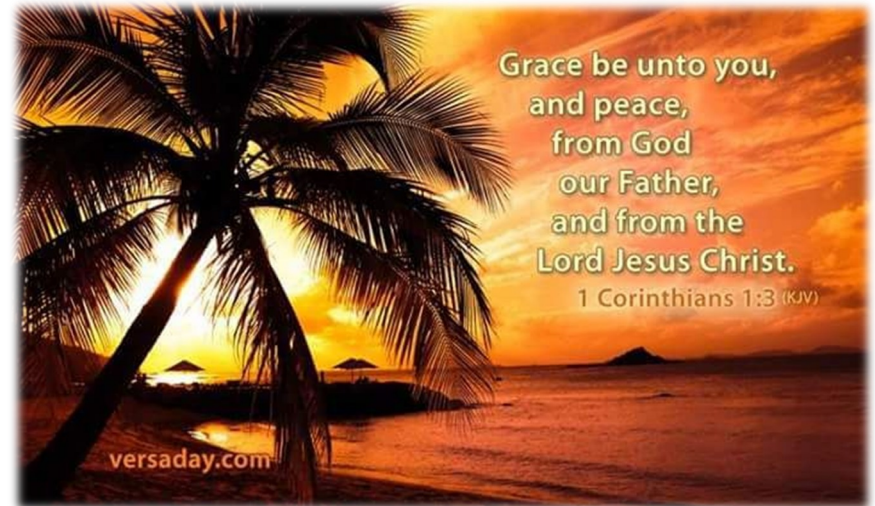
